Wayne College's associate degree program in Social Services Technology prepares you for preprofessional employment in social work and other human services. Completion of this degree will give you the credentials needed to apply for a Certificate of Registration as a Social Work Assistant.

Social Services Technology graduates are qualified for employment in a variety of exciting positions in human service organizations. Opportunities are available to work with families, youth, the elderly, special populations such as veterans, and chemically dependent individuals. Possible job titles include:

- Family Service Worker
- Activity Worker
- Child Care Worker
- Chemical Dependency Technician
- Social Services Worker
- Outreach Worker
- Program Coordinator
- Prevention Specialist

Your starting salary will depend on your level of education, skills, experience, the size of the company you work for, and your geographic area. Based on a survey of recent Wayne College graduates, starting annual salaries generally range between \$11,960 and \$18,500.

One of these courses is necessary if you wish to qualify for state registration as a social work assistant.

If you are pursuing an associate degree and have completed twelve or more semester credits, we suggest that you schedule an appointment with an academic adviser to declare your major officially and to produce a student degree agreement (contract).

The degree agreement is a formal statement of the courses that you must complete to satisfy your degree requirements. It is your safeguard against future college requirement changes in your program.
