Bays called the meeting to order.

The survey results will be reviewed by Deeds and areas of interest and emerging trends will be placed on the Fall agenda for the committee.

Final revisions made to laptop policy will be forward to the College Conference Committee. Clarification has been provided regarding the replacement of the previous laptop policy with this staff faculty policy.

Positive comments from the AURCO conference filled the evaluations and the conference is reported to be the best in 12 years.

Pay-to-print information was reviewed and discussion re-opened. Lerch expressed concerns about potential staffing problems that could be introduced with a pay-to-print policy implemented in the Library. Also a concern regarding students and their selections of materials and articles relating to the cost involved in printing the most substantial, comprehensive or scholarly articles for research. In addition, Lerch maintained a commitment to educating students about printing in the Library. Signage to encourage responsible printing was discussed for printers around the College. A monitoring system for user printing used on Akron campus is also being researched as a preliminary step to gather data before implementing the pay-to-print project at Wayne.
