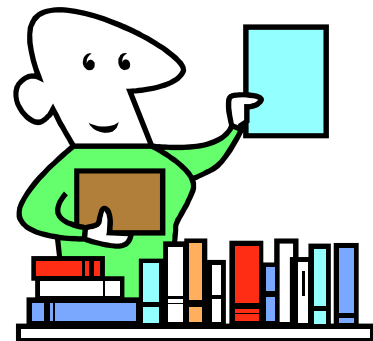
## BOOK DISCUSSION GROUP FORMING

## Subscription Databases to try (in addition to Academic Search Premier):

ANTE: Abstracts in New Technologies and Engineering: Coverage includes new technologies such as information technology and computing, electronics, biotechnology, medical technology, as well as engineering.

Applied Science and Technology Abstracts: Index to articles in aeronautics, chemistry, computer technology, energy, engineering, geology, mathematics, oceanography, physics, transportation, and other fields.

Biological Abstracts / BIOSIS Previews: Index and abstracts to international journal articles in biological and medical research. BIOSIS Previews also covers books and meetings.

CINAHL: Cumulative Index of Nursing and Allied Health Literature: Index and abstracts to the literature of nursing and allied health.

Health Source: Nursing / Academic Edition: Information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health.

History of Science, Technology and Medicine: Index to journal articles, books, proceedings, and other literature in the history of science, technology and medicine, and allied historical fields.

Lexis Nexis Academic: Full text news, business, legal, medical, and reference information.

Lexis Nexis Statistical: Statistical information from government and other sources; index and abstracts for statistical reports from the U.S. federal government.

Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center: Provides a complete one-stop source for information on social issues. Access viewpoint articles, topic overviews, statistics, primary documents, links to websites, and full-text magazine and newspaper articles.
