SUMMARY: COLLEGE ROADMAP 101 AT WAYNE COLLEGE

Orrville, Ohio, Sept. 10, 2007 – Navigating the trip from high school to college can be tricky. The University of Akron Wayne College is planning *College Road Map 101: Your family route to college* information session to help students and parents through the process.

College Road Map 101 will take place on Monday, Oct. 1, at 7:30 p.m. at the Wayne College campus in Orrville and Tuesday, Oct. 16, at 7 p.m. at the Holmes County Higher Education Center in Millersburg.

The information sessions will cover details about the college search process such as how to “work” the college fairs, what to look for during campus visits, where to begin the financial aid process and where to look for scholarships.

According to Admissions Counselor John Lorson, the main goal of the program is to have high school students thinking about college. “In Wayne County, only 22 percent of our residents have a college degree,” says Lorson. “We want that number to rise. While we would love for students to come to Wayne, our real goal is to have them going to college somewhere.”

Wayne College is a regional campus of The University of Akron, and offers the first two years of general bachelor’s degree courses for students who plan to complete their degrees at the Akron campus or other colleges and universities. The general education transfer program also leads to the associate of arts degree or the associate of science degree. In addition, Wayne College can prepare students for a variety of paraprofessional and technical careers in business, industry and public service by offering a range of occupational education programs. The campus is located at 1901 Smucker Road in Orrville.
