SUMMARY: NEW DEAN'S SCHOLARSHIP AT WAYNE COLLEGE

Orrville, Ohio, Jan. 16, 2008 – The University of Akron Wayne College has established a new scholarship for high achieving high school seniors. The Wayne College Dean's Scholarship was created to recognize outstanding academic work and to encourage continued educational growth. This most recent scholarship is the largest dollar amount awarded for an individual scholarship granted through Wayne.

One \$3,000 award will be available to a graduating senior from each of the following area high schools: Chippewa, Dalton, Rittman, Orrville, Wooster, East Holmes, West Holmes, Wadsworth, Wayne County Schools Career Center, Norwayne, Northwestern, Waynedale, Triway, Smithville, Kingsway Christian, and Central Christian. Applicants must be graduating, have a 3.75 grade point average or be in the top 10 percent of their classes, and/or received a 26 composite ACT score or 1150 SAT score.

“We have wanted to acknowledge and reward academically successful students and we feel this scholarship is a great way to do that,” says Wayne College Dean Jack Kristofco. “We’ve also wanted to encourage some of these students to begin their college years here at Wayne where they will benefit from small classes and individual attention, and they will enhance the educational experience of other students.”

The Dean's Scholarship is not need-based; however, applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to ensure receipt of all financial aid that might be available to them.
