SUMMARY: EDUCATION MASTER'S DEGREE OFFERED AT WAYNE COLLEGE

Orrville, Ohio, July 18, 2007 – The University of Akron's College of Education and Wayne College will offer master's degree options in literacy and educational administration. Classes will be held at the Wayne College campus in Orrville, with the possibility of some groups meeting in Wooster or Millersburg.

This degree is designed for educators who currently have their bachelor's degree and who would like to continue their education close to home. Classes will be scheduled to accommodate people who are working full-time. Partial-tuition scholarships are available to all participants and will allow students to purchase three credits for the price of two.

Applications and transcripts are due by July 31 to the Graduate Outreach Program at The University of Akron.
